- 1. You must interview with Dr. Ward. The interview will explain the specific responsibilities of student council officers.
- 2. You must have at least one year of student leadership experience. One year activity in any of the following will count toward your year of leadership experience: student council representative, national honor society member, or a prefect who can document at least nine hours of service.
- 3. You must apply for the office, and your application must be approved by the student leadership committee.

To campaign:

- 1. You may post campaign signs beginning Monday, May 12.
- 2. Signs must be removed by 8:00 am Friday, May 23.
- 3. Signs must be approved by Dr. Ward before they can be posted.
- 4. Signs may be posted only in public areas where there is cork board or a tack strip. Signs may not be posted in classrooms.
- 5. You may not offer any kind of gift (food, etc.) to the student body during your campaign. No one may do so on your behalf. If you violate this policy the student leadership committee has the right to disqualify you as a candidate.
- 6. You must sign below and turn in a copy of this document to the Campus Life office.
