(Yes, I will check and give a daily grade for your annotations!) At the end of the second full week of school, your response essay will be due. Choose one event or person, for example, to analyze. The analysis should contain your personal review or opinion of the event or person in the book, with sufficient explanation to support your view. <u>The essay should be your original work</u>, and you should incorporate at least three quotes from the book to support the analysis. Type the final copy; save it on your computer so that you may make revisions after we edit the essay. Use MLA typing format for the paper.
