Middle School (6th-8th) Dress Code The Brook Hill School 2022-2023

*Please note that only Land's End and Academy Uniforms brands are "BH approved".

Dress Code The administration reserves the right to determine if a student is dressed and groomed appropriately and may ask the student to make changes if they deem it necessary Brook Hill has chosen to implement the dress code policy by the adoption of a uniform program. It is required that all uniforms be purchased from Land's End or Academy Uniforms brand clothing. Students are expected to adhere to the dress code while officially representing Brook Hill.

Girls' Daily Attire (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday)

- Khaki, navy, or plaid uniform skirt/skort; khaki or navy uniform pants/shorts; navy polo dress
- Navy or white uniform polo shirt
- Closed-toe shoes

Boys' Daily Attire (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday)

- Khaki or navy uniform pants/shorts
- Navy or white uniform polo shirt (tucked in)
- o Brown, black, or navy belt
- Closed-toe shoes

Girls' Chapel Attire

- o Khaki, navy, or plaid uniform skirt
- White uniform blouse (tucked in)
- Solid white or navy socks
- Closed-toe dress flat, dress boot, or deck shoes (no athletic shoes, tennis shoes, or Keds)
- BH approved sweater, sweater vest, or navy cardigan may be worn with uniform blouse. No outerwear can be worn during chapel service.
- No hoodies or sweatshirts may be worn on chapel day.

Boys' Chapel Attire

- Navy or khaki uniform pants
- Uniform white oxford shirt (tucked in)
- o BH uniform tie
- o Brown, black, or navy belt
- Closed-toe deck shoes, dress shoes, or cowboy boots (no athletic shoes or tennis shoes)
- BH approved sweater, sweater vest, or navy cardigan may be worn with uniform oxford shirt. No outerwear can be worn during chapel
- No hoodies or sweatshirts may be worn on chapel day.

Girls' Friday Dress:

- o Jeans, pants, or shorts (must be solid navy, orange, white, gray, khaki only and uniform length)
- o Brook Hill approved t-shirts/spirit shirts or uniform polo shirt
- Closed-toe shoes
- NOT ALLOWED: inappropriately tight jeans or pants; jeggings or leggings: athletic shorts; or jeans with rips, holes, frays, or tears. Boys' Friday Dress:
- o Jeans, pants, or shorts (must be solid navy, orange, white, gray, khaki only and uniform length)
- Brook Hill approved t-shirts/spirit shirts or uniform polo shirt
- Closed-toe shoes
- NOT ALLOWED: inappropriately tight jeans or pants; athletic shorts; or jeans with rips, holes, frays, or tears.

Dress Code Guidelines for Girls:

- o Only BH approved outerwear (jackets, sweatshirts, hoodies) is allowed.
- o Khaki color MUST match the Land's End and Academy Uniform khaki.
- o Pants and shorts must be worn above or at the hips.
- O Shorts must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- Appropriate undergarments and modesty shorts are to be worn under skirts at all times.
- No sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, moccasin-type footwear, shoes with wheels, house shoes/slippers may be worn at any time.
- Warm-ups, skinny jeans, and jeggings are not acceptable.
- o Leggings (solid white or solid navy) may be worn under uniform skirt only.
- o Skirt length must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- o Polo shirts may be worn tucked in or left out.
- Only solid white t-shirts or tanks (without writing) may be worn under white uniform shirts or chapel blouse.
- Tanks or shirts worn under navy polo shirts must be either navy, orange, white, or gray with no visible writing.
- Hats may not be worn during the school day.
- Dress Code Guidelines for Boys:
- o Only BH approved outerwear (jackets, sweatshirts, hoodies) is allowed.
- o Khaki color MUST match the Land's End and Academy Uniform khaki.
- o Pants and shorts must be worn above or at the hips.
- Shorts must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- No sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, moccasin-type footwear, shoes with wheels, house shoes/slippers may be worn at any time.
- o Shirts must be tucked into pants or shorts, except when wearing Friday dress.
- Belts (black, brown, or navy) must be worn, except when wearing Friday dress.
- Only solid white t-shirts (without writing) may be worn under white uniform shirts.
- Shirts worn under navy polo shirts must be either navy, orange, white, or gray with no visible writing.
- Hats may not be worn during the school day.

Additional Guidelines for Girls:

- o Abnormal or extreme hairstyles as determined by the administration are not permitted.
- At all before school and after school Brook Hill events (sporting events, fine arts events, etc.), students do not need to be in uniform but must follow similar guidelines.
- Students may be asked to cover tattoos.
- Highlighting and coloring of hair is permitted as long as it is dyed a natural color.
- Jewelry should be modest with no oversized earrings and necklaces and should not draw attention to self. No piercing other than ears.
- Appropriate attire is expected at all Brook Hill dances. Specific dress guidelines will be communicated to the student body prior to the dance.

Additional Guidelines for Boys:

- No piercings are allowed. Earrings are not allowed.
- Hair may not go past the bottom of the collar or be below the middle of the ears and must be trimmed at or above the eyebrows. Hair may be tied up with a hair tie in order to meet these requirements.
- No facial hair is permitted. Students must be clean shaven at all times. Sideburns may not extend below the earlobe.
- o Abnormal or extreme hairstyles as determined by the administration are not permitted.
- At all Brook Hill events (sporting events, fine arts events, etc.), student do not need to be in uniform but must follow similar guidelines.
- Students may be asked to cover tattoos
- o Highlighting and coloring of hair is permitted as long as it is dyed a natural color.
- Appropriate attire is expected at all Brook Hill dances. Specific dress guidelines will be communicated to the student body prior to the dance.

- o 2nd Violation Disciplinary Referral
- 3rd Violation Disciplinary Referral/Lunch Detention
- o 4th Violation Disciplinary Referral/ISS or After School Detention
- o 5th Violation Saturday School
- o Additional violations will be handled at the discretion of the administration.

Students will begin each semester with zero dress code violations.
