HOW DO I INSTALL VIDIGAMI ON MY DEVICE?

Vidigami works as a "responsive website" on any device with a web browser. We encouraged you to install the Vidigami progressive web app on your phone to have easy access to the platform. Follow the instructions below to install the platform onto your device.

Safari on iPhone or iPad

- 1. Visit **app.vidigami.com** in the Safari web browser.
- 2. Log in to Vidigami with your credentials.
- 3. Once logged in, tap the "Share" icon at the bottom of Safari:



4. From the menu that appears, scroll down, and tap on "Add to Home Screen":

Here are the top 3 things you can do in Vidigami:

- 1. If you see a photo of your child, <u>tag</u> it! This will help us and you have a personal collection of photos of your child's experience and years at Brook Hill.
- 2. If you take a great photo at a school event, <u>share</u> it! This helps us have photos of every event, big or small, that happens at our school.
- 3. If you see a photo you like, <u>save</u> it or <u>download</u> it!

Next to the Feeds tab is <u>Explore</u> - this is our digital media library, a directory of Pages capturing all our Classes, Athletics, Fine Arts and Campus Life Events for the school year. You will be able to see all the content for any given school year.
