

Middle School Dress Code

The Brook Hill School 2025-2026

*Please note that only Land's End and The Guard shop are "BH approved".

Dress Code The administration reserves the right to determine if a student is dressed and groomed appropriately and may ask the student to make changes if they deem it necessary Brook Hill has chosen to implement the dress code policy by the adoption of a uniform program. It is required that all uniforms be purchased from Land's End or Guard Shop clothing. Students are expected to adhere to the dress code while officially representing Brook Hill.

Girls' Daily Attire (Monday, Wednesday, Thursday)

- Khaki, navy, or plaid uniform skirt/skort; khaki or navy uniform pants/shorts; navy polo dress
- Navy, white, orange, gray uniform polo shirt
- Closed-toe shoes
- Athletic shorts are to be worn under skirts at all times

Boys' Daily Attire (Monday, Wednesday, Thursday)

- Khaki or navy uniform pants/shorts-(a button and zipper)
- Navy, white, orange, gray uniform polo shirt (tucked in)
- Brown, black, or navy belt must be worn
- Closed-toe shoes

Girls' Chapel Attire (Tuesday)

- Khaki, navy, or plaid uniform skirt/skort
- White uniform blouse or white oxford (tucked in)
- Closed-toe shoes
- Athletic shorts are to be worn under skirts at all times

Boys' Chapel Attire (Tuesday)

- Khaki or Navy uniform pants
- Uniform white oxford shirt or white oxford (tucked in)
- BH uniform tie (Land's End)
- Brown, black, or navy belt must be worn
- Closed-toe shoes or cowboy boots

Girls' Friday Dress:

- Jeans, uniform pants, uniform shorts, or uniform skirts
- BH t-shirts/spirit shirts or uniform polo shirt
- Closed-toe shoes
- NOT ALLOWED:
 - Inappropriately tight jeans
 - Jeggings
 - Leggings

- Joggers
- Sweatpants
- Athletic shorts
- Jeans with rips, holes, frays, or tears
- Tennis skirts

Boys' Friday Dress

- Jeans, uniform pants, uniform shorts
- BH t-shirts/spirit shirts or uniform polo shirt
- Closed-toe shoes
- NOT ALLOWED:
 - Inappropriately tight jeans
 - Joggers
 - Sweatpants
 - Athletic shorts
 - Jeans with rips, holes, frays, or tears

Dress Code Guidelines for Girls:

- Only BH outerwear (jackets, sweatshirts, hoodies) is allowed.
- Khaki color MUST match the Land's End khaki.
- Pants and shorts must be worn above or at the hips.
- Skirts and Shorts must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- Skirts are not to be rolled
- Athletic shorts are to be worn under skirts at all times.
- No sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, moccasin-type footwear, shoes with wheels, or house shoes/slippers, (this includes slides) may be worn at any time.
- Warm-ups, skinny jeans, jeggings, joggers, and pajama pants are not acceptable.
- Leggings (solid white or solid navy) may be worn under uniform skirt **only**.
- Polo shirts may be worn tucked in or left out.

- Only solid white t-shirts or tanks (without writing) may be worn under white uniform shirts or chapel blouse.
- **Hats may not be worn during the school day.**

Dress Code Guidelines for Boys:

- Only BH outerwear (jackets, sweatshirts, hoodies) is allowed.
- Khaki color MUST match the Land's End and Academy Uniform khaki.
- Pants and shorts must be worn above or at the hips.
- Shorts must be mid-thigh or longer in length.
- No sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, moccasin-type footwear, shoes with wheels, or house shoes/slippers (this includes the slides) may be worn at any time.
- Shirts must be tucked into pants or shorts, except when wearing Friday dress.
- Belts (black, brown, or navy) must be worn, except when wearing Friday dress.
- Only solid white t-shirts (without writing) may be worn under white uniform shirts.
- **Hats may not be worn during the school day.**

Additional Guidelines for Girls:

- Abnormal or extreme hairstyles as determined by the administration are not permitted.
- At all before school and after school Brook Hill events (sporting events, fine arts events, etc.), students do not need to be in uniform but must follow similar guidelines.
- Students may be asked to cover tattoos.
- Highlighting and coloring of hair is permitted as long as it is dyed a natural color.

Dress Code Violations

Students will promptly be made to comply with the dress code before returning to class.

- 1st Violation – Verbal Warning
- 2nd Violation – Disciplinary Referral
- 3rd Violation – Disciplinary Referral/Lunch Detention
- 4th Violation – Disciplinary Referral/ISS or After School Detention
- 5th Violation - Saturday School
- Additional violations will be handled at the discretion of the administration.

Students begin each semester with zero dress code violations.

- Jewelry should be modest with no oversized earrings and necklaces and should not draw attention to self. No piercing other than ears.
- Appropriate attire is expected at all Brook Hill dances. Specific dress guidelines will be communicated to the student body prior to the dance.

Additional Guidelines for Boys:

- No piercings are allowed. Earrings are not allowed.
- Hair may not go past the bottom of the collar or be below the middle of the ears and must be trimmed at or above the eyebrows. If hair does not meet the above requirements, hair must be tied up neatly or trimmed to meet the requirements.
- No facial hair is permitted. Students must be clean shaven at all times. Sideburns may not extend below the earlobe.
- Abnormal or extreme hairstyles as determined by the administration are not permitted.
- At all Brook Hill events (sporting events, fine arts events, etc.), students do not need to be in uniform but must follow similar guidelines.
