 - A quiz over the book will be given the first week of school.

 - A grade will be given for completion.
- Design a game based on the book.
 - It can be a board game, card game, guessing game, matching game, etc. Be creative and have fun!
 - Must be created by student only.
 - The game should include 10 or more questions about the book.
- Bring your game to Meet the Teacher (8/10/26) or the first day of school (8/12/26).
 - We will play our new games during the first week of 3rd grade.
- Practice reading your favorite part and be prepared to read it out loud to your teacher. It should be at least half a page to a whole page in length. Mark it with a sticky note so it will be easy to find!
